For much of Christian's life, we have bounced between residential and school placements. Christian struggled to connect with his teachers and peers. At each school, Christian would tell me that he didn't have friends. He felt alone.

I did everything I possibly could for my son, even moving school districts to give him a better shot at the education and community he needed and deserved.
